INTRODUCTION

This index has been compiled by Don Saunders, a Senior Technical Officer with the National Parks Authority. It contains selected references to articles from the Victorian Naturalist, volumes 1 to 86 inclusive (covering the period January 1884 to December 1969), published by the Field Naturalists' Club of Victoria.

Approximately 80 localities and 21 natural history subjects have been included.

The index was originally compiled by Mr. Saunders for his own use as a Technical Officer of this Authority. Hence the references have been selected with a particular use in mind, and with respect to some subjects it is not comprehensive. But from time to time copies of the original manuscript (or of part of it) have been sought by research workers and others. The Authority has therefore, with the permission of the Field Naturalists' Club, arranged reproduction of the index in its present form to meet such needs. It is hoped that the index will prove helpful to those who use it.
